October: Pablo Picasso

Fun facts:

His full name was Pablo Diego José Francisco de Paula Juan Nepomuceno María de los Remedios Cipriano de la Santísima Trinidad Martyr Patricio Clito Ruíz y Picasso. His father started teaching art to him when he was seven years old. Picasso was a co-founder in the movement known as Cubism. This style reduces the subjects to geometric forms. Picasso produced a total of 1,200 sculptures and 1,800 paintings in his entire lifetime. In 1935, at the age of 53, he also started to write poetry.





On October 19th, Gate City will be participating in the Nashua Art Walk. Gate City Staff will have a table set-up where students and the community can participate in music games and art activities.


