Fun facts:

Salvador Dali was born on May 11, 1904 in Figueres, Catalonia. Dali had a pet anteater. He had a fear of all insects, especially grasshoppers and ants. He was famous for his long, curly, and uniquely-shaped mustache. His most famous painting was inspired by a piece of melting cheese. Dali concentrated much of his work on Surrealism which means “above realism”.

JUST A FEW REMINDERS TO START THE NEW YEAR:
