4th grade Chain Reaction Machines

Where does energy come from and how is it released? After learning about roller coasters and energy transfer through videos and the creation of paper tracks, it was clear that the 4th grade has a thirst for exploring more about chain reaction machines. Chain reaction devices, or Rube Goldberg machines, are complex machines that perform a very simple task. Using classroom supplies, as well as random objects brought from home, 4th grade was given a week to create any kind of chain reaction machine they wanted. They were given the choice to work alone or in teams. Each group tried and failed hundreds of times in their pursuit. They used domino effects with different objects, like books, levers fashioned

from rulers and plastic tracks, and even pulley systems! Students also drew their final designs, and labeled the places where energy was stored and how it was released.
